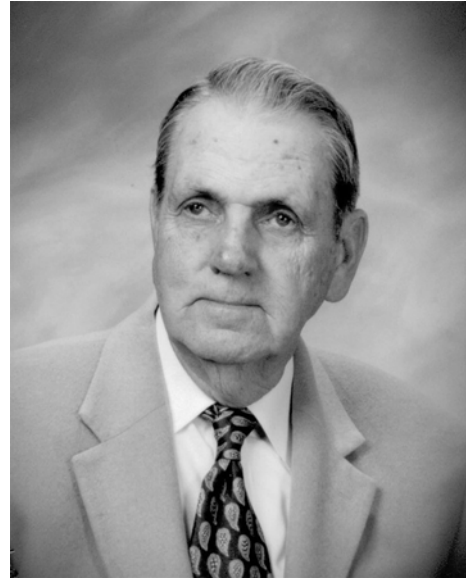


## 2009 CLARK COUNTY FAIR DEDICATION

Carl E. Mumma  
December 20, 1922 - September 03, 2006**

Carl E. Mumma was born December 20, 1922. After serving in the United States Navy during World War II, Carl returned home and joined his father in the family business. His father started the family business, Mumma Auctioneers and Mumma Realty, in 1910. Carl was the second of four generations at Mumma Auctioneers and Mumma Realty where he was an auctioneer and real estate broker for 61 years.

Carl was elected Clark County Commissioner in 1968 and served two full terms until 1976. He served as a member of the Board of Directors of Springfield Federal Savings & Loan later known as Cornerstone Bank for 25 years. Carl was a member of Grace United Methodist Church, a charter member of the Enon Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 8437 and he belonged to the New Carlisle Lodge 100 Free and Accepted Masons. He was a member of the Northwood Hills Country club where he was an avid golfer. For 5 years, Carl served on the Clark County Fair Board and for 44 years participated in the livestock auctions.
