**Dates will be announced during the Fair. Out of county premium checks will be mailed.**

1. This is an open class show, but the Alpaca and Llama Show Association (ALSA) rulebook will serve as guidelines for the show.
2. Deadline for entry is June 30, 2009 at 4:30 p.m. All entries must be mailed or delivered to the Clark County Fair, 4401 S. Charleston Pike, Springfield, OH 45502.
3. Entry forms must include animal's registration forms: either ILR (International Llama registry), CLAA (Canadian Llama and Alpaca Association) or ARI (Alpaca Registry Inc.) Unregistered animals may be shown; however they must be shown in the adult class.
4. Animals from within Ohio must be free of disease; animals from out of state must provide applicable health papers to be checked by the show superintendent or designee. No animal showing any obvious sign of disease will be allowed in the barn.
5. Animals must be in place by 11 a.m.
6. Entry fee is \$20 per animal and must be included with the entry form. Premiums will be paid out based on number of entries in each class; premiums for champion and reserve champion are based on sponsorship contributions.
7. Only Halter classes will be offered; no showmanship or performance classes.
8. Get of Sire and Produce of Dam classes: individual animals included in each entry of the Get of Sire (three animals from the same sire) or Produce of Dam (two animals from the same dam) classes MUST be shown in their individual halter classes before being shown in the Get or Produce Class. Entries are made in the NAME of the sire or dam; the sire or dam IS NOT entered.
9. Classes may be combined or split according to size or fiber type.
10. Llama wool classes will include:
  - a. Suri: having a natural luster and hang or drape over the body, forming natural part along the spine. Fiber falls into a well-defined lock structure.
  - b. Light Wool: minimum to moderate body wool, smooth to minimum head, ear and leg wool
  - c. Medium: Moderate to long body wool, minimal to moderate neck wool, smooth to moderate leg wool.
  - d. Heavy Wool: Abundant body and neck wool with minimal to abundant leg wool, i.e. leg wool at least to knee and hock.
11. Alpaca Classes:
  - a. All alpacas must be shorn; judging will be based on conformation and type.
  - b. Suri: having a natural luster and hang or drape over the body, forming natural part along the spine. Fiber falls into a well-defined lock structure.
  - c. Huacaya: Having a natural crimp and shine to the fiber.
12. Animal age breakdown (Note: all animal's age is based from their birth date to the day of the show)
  - a. Juvenile: 6-11 months old
  - b. Yearling: 12-23 months old
  - c. Adult: 24+ months old
